Curbside absentee voting will be available in the **north Courthouse parking lot May 4–June 1.**

Call us at 712-364-2626 if you have any questions or to schedule an appointment. We are here to help you.

Why are we doing this?

- 1) We do not want to expose poll workers/employees and the public to this virus.
- 2) We are trying to limit exposure to the public so we may have limited staff on Election Day.
Depending on the progress of this virus, it is probable that the Courthouse may be the only polling location on Election Day.
