

RESOLUTION 22-34

ESTABLISHING LOCAL GOVERNMENT OPIOID ABATEMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisor's entered into opioid settlement agreements pursuant to Resolution 21-41 dated December 7, 2021,

WHEREAS, it is desired to establish a special revenue fund to account for expenditures and revenues of the Ida County Opioid Abatement Fund,

WHEREAS, the fund established shall be a special revenue fund, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ida County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes to Establish a Special Revenue Fund, now known as Fund 0037 Local Government Opioid Abatement Fund, effective upon the date of passage of this Resolution

The Auditor is directed to create this fund and notify the affected parties of the proper accounting codes.
