Registration forms are available on the https://sos.iowa.gov website. Register online at https://sos.iowa.gov website. Pre-Registration deadline is 5:00 p.m., Monday, October 24, 2022.

Election Day Registration. You may register in person at the Auditor's Office prior to November 8, 2022 or at your polling place on Election Day by presenting a current photo ID which include-lowa or Out of state driver's license or non driver ID card, US passport, US Military ID or Veteran's ID, ID card from an employer, Student ID issued by lowa high school or college or Tribal ID Card/Document and proof of residency which must include name and current address and be current within 45 days, may be in an electronic format or on paper-Residential lease, Utility bill, including cell phone bill, paycheck, property tax statement, bank statement, government check or other government issued document to the election officials.

**ABSENTEE VOTING IN THE AUDITOR'S OFFICE: Absentee ballots will be available on Wednesday, October 19, 2022 at the Ida County Auditor's Office and may be voted in the office until 4:30 p.m. Monday, November 7, 2022.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS BY MAIL: A ballot may be mailed to you upon receiving your request. Requests can be made in writing (you must include your name, ID#/Driver's License or 4 digit pin, registered address, date of birth, name and date of election, mail to address if different from registered address and signature and date.
