Pursuant to Iowa Code Section 441.49, the undersigned Department of Revenue of the State of Iowa hereby notifies you of the final percentage adjustments to the 2023 valuations of real property in Ida County:

Assessed values are equalized by the department of revenue every two years. Local taxing authorities determine the final tax levies and may reduce property tax rates to compensate for any increase in valuation due to equalization. If the above adjustment will result in a greater value than permitted Iowa Code section 441.21, taxpayers may protest the final equalization order as it applies to their valuation with their local board of review (under Iowa Code section 441.49(4)) on or after October 8, to and including October 31.
