**ELECTION UPDATE**: In person absentee and curbside voting has begun at the Auditor's Office-401 Moorehead St. until June 4<sup>th</sup> Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m.-4:30 p.m. Courthouse voting will be done in the downstairs of the Courthouse. Please bring an ID. We will try to limit it to only 4 people in the hallway at a time! If there are excess voters, we will ask you to leave us your phone number and return to your vehicle until we call you.

Since we have no idea of the volume of in person voting, we are asking the public to please be patient.

<u>Curbside Voting</u>—If you are unable to come into the Courthouse to vote, park in the East parking lot @ the Sheriff's Office entrance. Call 712-364-2626. Stay in your vehicle. We will verify your registration and ask for your birthdate, Driver's License or PIN number and address. Have your ID available! Again, please be patient!!

Safe Voting by Mail!! You can complete an absentee ballot request form and send it to our office. Call our office if you need a form or download one from the SOS.lowa.Gov website. Monday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 5 p.m. is the last day that you can request an absentee ballot to be mailed and the last day to pre-register to vote. Absentee voting in our office is available now through June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024, until 4:30 p.m. to vote in person. We will be open Saturday, June 1, 2024, 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. You can track your absentee ballot on VOTERREADY.lowa.gov website.

Returning voted ballots: Make sure to sign in the yellow box on the return envelope and seal the envelope. It must be signed and sealed to count the ballot! Voted ballots can be brought to our office or mailed. Mailed ballots must be received by Election Day, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2024 prior to 8 a.m. Any Questions—Please call—712-364-2626.
