Subject to provisions of other county procedures and regulations, and applicable state law, the appropriations authorized under Section 1 shall constitute authorization for the department or officer listed to make expenditures or incur obligations from the itemized fund, effective July 1, 2024

Section 3. In accordance with 331.437, Code of lowa, no department or officer shall expend or contract to expend and money or incur any liability, or enter into any contract which by its terms involves the expenditure of money for any purpose in excess of the amounts appropriated pursuant to this resolution.

Section 4. If at any time during the 2024-2025 budget year the Auditor shall as certain that the available resources of a department for that year will be less that said department total appropriations, she shall immediately so inform the Board and recommend appropriate corrective action.

Section 5. The Auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in Section 1, each of which account shall indicate the amount of the appropriations, the amounts charged thereto, and the unencumbered balance. The Auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable departments and officers monthly during the 2024-2025 budget year.

Section 6. All Appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at close of business June 30, 2025.
