

Resolution 25-32

WHEREAS, the Ida County Board of Supervisors and the Ida County Conservation Board desire to provide outdoor recreation facilities and services for its citizens and visitors, and

WHEREAS, the Ida County Conservation Board seeks to continue the methods by which it appropriates the funds it receives, and

WHEREAS, the Ida County Board of Supervisors desires to preserve the integrity of funding the actions and programs of the Ida County Conservation Board, and

WHEREAS, the Ida County Board of Supervisors understands the economic impact of the Conservation Board's functions, and

WHEREAS, the Ida County Conservation Board collects numerous funds in the form of user fees, those being monies generated from conservation lands and facilities, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Ida County Board of Supervisors to allow 50% of collected fees from the camp sites from Crawford Creek to be credited to the General Fund Designated for Conservation Purposes Fund, account number 0003-1-22-6110-52301.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ida County Board of Supervisors hereby orders that 50% all fees collected from the Crawford Creek camp sites be credited to the General Fund Designated for Conservation Purposes Fund, and to be used at the discretion of the Conservation Board for conservation purposes as identified in Chapter 350 of the Code of Iowa, effective July 1, 2025.
