RESOLUTION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF TWO STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF BRADY AVENUE AND 180<sup>TH</sup> STREET

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 321.236 and 321.255 of the current Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors and County Engineer are empowered to designate the location and erection of STOP signs,

WHEREAS, this is currently an uncontrolled intersection,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Ida County Board of Supervisors on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2025, recognize as official, the location of two STOP signs at the intersection described below:

1. Located in Section 9, T88N, R41W, designated as the intersection of Brady Avenue and 180<sup>th</sup> Street, causing traffic west bound on 180<sup>th</sup> Street to come to a complete stop.
2. Located in Section 8, T88N, R41W, designated as the intersection of Brady Avenue and 180<sup>th</sup> Street, causing traffic south bound on Brady Avenue to come to a complete stop.
