

**RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION OF TRAFFIC-BASED PRIORITIZED BLADING SCHEDULE**

**IDA COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 26-12**

WHEREAS, Ida County desires to formally prioritize blading frequency of granular Farm-To-Market roadways and more highly traveled granular routes.

WHEREAS, the County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has identified the more highly trafficked gravel roadways in each motor grader territory throughout the County.

WHEREAS, the County has deemed it acceptable to potentially blade the lesser-travelled roadways less frequently as necessitated to increase the frequency of the maintenance of the higher travelled gravel roadways and gravel Farm-To-Market roadways.

WHEREAS, the County does recognize that, in the event of future growth and changing traffic patterns, the roadways marked as higher priority shall be reviewed every four years and updated as needed.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF IDA COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the highlighted roadways on the accompanying map as higher blading priority routes.
