

The Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on March 31, 2026, at 9:05 a.m. Members present Devlun Whiteing, Creston Schubert and Kyle Rohlk. Whiteing called the meeting to order. A motion to approve minutes from March 16, 2026, by Rohlk, seconded by Schubert. Motion carried all voting Aye. There were no public comments to the board.

John Huff from MidAmerican Energy met with the board about the repowering ordinance they are proposing. This is a starting point for both sides. The board will investigate this further and have a workshop specific to this in the future. No action was taken. County Attorney Meghann Cosgrove-Whitmer was also present at the meeting.
